### 18/07.2 **ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH**

Tarmac sprinklers have been repaired and the road sweeping hours increased.  
Tarmac hours have been extended to avoid vehicles queuing.  
Cllr Roose reported that the wheel wash sprinklers are not working as the pump has broken.  
There have been a number of complaints of chatter etc on the road by the traffic lights.  
Cllr Beckett witnessed a substance come off a Volmix lorry.

### 18/07.3 **TARMAC**

The area around the wheel wash has been re-surfaced. Loading times have been increased and a new system implemented at the weighbridge to help prevent queuing onto the road.

### 18/07.4 **SLINTER MINING CO LTD**

Pecking only takes place after 9am. A road sweeper and sprinkler have been put in place to help with dust. The soil heaps have been tidied. The planning application will be considered in August.
